FACULTY OF VETERINARY MEDICINE



Firat University Faculty of Veterinary Medicine; It is the second veterinary faculty in Turkish history and the first established in the history of the Republic.

It was established in 1970.

It has a total of 114 academic staff, including 72 Professors, 9 Associate Professors, 4 Doctoral Faculty Members and 29 Research Assistants. In addition, this faculty is a member of VEDEK (Association for Evaluation and Accreditation of Veterinary Education Institutions and Programs) and EAEVE (European Association of Veterinary Education Institutions), which inspects veterinary schools in all European Union countries. It received conditional accreditation by EAEVE in 2011 and full accreditation in 2013


**Elazığ has no sea but

tourism.**






SAKLIKAN KARALEYLERK CANYON

Sevenkind spice, orcik, sugared almond...



MARDIN

Mardin invites you inside with its historical stone Crown Gate embroidered with Seljuks. If you agree to be a guest of this city, it will be inevitable that you will be fascinated by the warm colors of stone works.

Mardin, which has hosted 18 different cultures since the 4500s BC to the present day, blends the traces of each cultures in these stone works and presents them to the guests.



GÖBEKLİTEPE

Göbeklitepe, the hill of the firsts located in Şanlıurfa; It was built 7,500 years before the Egyptian pyramids, were found the first signs of wheat a symbol of settled life, and it is the first known worship center in the history of religions, is just a quick summary of why visitors found it precious.

Besides, Göbeklitepe, which has not fallen off the news with various myths continues to shake the history with new excavations.



According to historical and scientific data, Balıklıgöl pools are ancient pagan temples built for the goddess Atargatis, who is half woman, half fish. And according to another rumor: When the prophet Abraham started to fight the cruel ruler of the time, Nemrut (Babylonian ruler) and the idols worshiped by his people, and defended the idea of one god, he was thrown into the fire by Nemrut from the hill where today's Urfa Castle is located. At this time, the command "Oh! fire, be cool and safe for Abraham" is given to the fire by Allah. Upon this order, fire turns into water and wood turns into fish. İbrahim falls alive into a rose garden

Pertek

Elazığ is not just what it seems. Pertek, one of the rare places where you can take a ferry on a dam lake in the Eastern Anatolian region of Turkey; With its natural hot springs, historical castles and a modest pier, it supports the history of Elazığ from the opposite side of the water.

Bingöl, the City of Lakes which is known for its natural beauties has ownership natural spring waters because of its altitude and terrain.
